This position deals extensively with networking and security to ensure secure credit card processing, defend associated systems from threats, and help maintain our PCI-DSS Level1 compliance. Key responsibilities include architecting and maintaining our cloud infrastructure. Additional responsibilities may include, but are not limited to: managing firewalls, routers and switches; involvement in the implementation of new security solutions; patching systems; collecting and managing evidence for PCI compliance; creation and/or maintenance of policies, standards, and procedures; and conducting vulnerability audits and assessments. This is a hands-on technical role.

An ideal candidate will be well-versed in IT infrastructure vulnerabilities and industry best practices in securing IT systems. Strong problem-solving abilities are required. This is a mid-level position requiring 7+ years technical experience.
